Services Description for Quality Reporting

MNCM has been named a Qualified Clinical Data Registry (QCDR) by CMS for the upcoming Merit-based Incentive Payment System (MIPS) under Medicare’s Quality Payment Program (QPP). A QCDR is a CMS-approved entity that collects and validates clinical data on behalf of clinicians and submits it to CMS. Through your current single data submission to MNCM, results can now be submitted to CMS for QPP reporting in addition to the current local results reporting.

- Option 1: MNCM Integrated QCDR: Six Measures**
This service is for current data submitters to MNCM. Seamless fulfillment of MIPS submission using MNCM’s six approved measures: **Colorectal Cancer Screening, Optimal Diabetes Care, Optimal Vascular Care, Optimal Asthma Control, Diabetes Hemoglobin A1C Poor Control and Ischemic (IVD): Use of Aspirin.** This level of participation will help you avoid financial penalties in 2019 and may help you earn a positive payment adjustment.
- Option 2: MNCM Integrated QCDR: One “Test” Measure**
This service is for current data submitters to MNCM. Seamless fulfillment of MIPS basic submission needs with maximum of one “test” measure. This level of participation will help you avoid financial penalties in 2019.

In addition, MNCM is partnering with a certified Registry vendor to be able to submit additional QPP measures to CMS. This is the PQRS program offered in previous years. This option will require additional data files submitted through this vehicle solely for the purpose of the MIPS program.

- Option 3: Stand Alone Submission: Multiple Measures**
This service is separate data file submissions and may help maximize a positive payment adjustment. If you choose this Option, a contract will be executed for signature. Powered by **PHYSICIAN COMPASS**

MNCM, as a QCDR, can submit attestations to CMS to qualify for Improvement Activity reporting, a separate module under QPP.

- Additional Service: Improvement Activity Reporting**
Submit attestations for 4 Improvement Activities to CMS as another component of the overall MIPS program. IA selection will occur within the MNCM data portal at <https://data.mnccm.org/login>. A complete list of all IAs is located [here](#).

Final sign off will occur in the MNMCM data portal for the QCDR Options upon data submission. Signoff for the Stand Alone option will occur directly with clinicians. Registry service fees will be invoiced after successful submission of measurement results to CMS in 2018.
